Reporting Live from the Great Park is a standards-based, STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math)-focused program for first graders using "disguised learning" to build knowledge of scientific investigation, physical science, geography, earth science, technology, language and visual arts.

Students ride the Great Park Balloon and tour the Farm + Food Lab, conducting fieldwork and experiments, then articulate what they learn by recording a news report at the OCGP-TV Studio in the Tierra Verde Industries Learning Center. Garden instruction is conducted by the University of California Cooperative Extension Master Gardeners.
